# Poverty Mapping using Clustering

## Aim of the Project

The aim of the project is to use data mining technique viz clustering for poverty mapping based on Schedule 63\_1.0 consumer expenditure of Socio Economic Survey Sixty third round (July 2006 – June 2007) (Report of NSS) . The main focus is to find the percentage of people below poverty line. Further it has been analyzed as to which community is poorest in different states. This will help the Government to take necessary steps to alleviate poverty in different states and try to uplift the community which is below poverty line in majority of states.

Data used

Socio Economic Survey Sixty third round (July 2006 – June 2007)

## Data Mining technique used

For poverty mapping, clustering technique which is a popular unsupervised learning technique has been used. Details of clustering are given below:

### Clustering

Clustering is a data mining task used to cluster observations into groups of related observations without any prior knowledge of those relationships. The k-means algorithm is one of the popular clustering techniques and it is commonly used in variety of applications.

### k-means Algorithm

The k-means algorithm is an evolutionary algorithm that gains its name from its method of operation. The algorithm clusters observations into k groups, where k is provided as an input parameter. It then assigns each observation to clusters based upon the observation's proximity to the mean of the cluster. The cluster's mean is then recomputed and the process begins again. Here's The algorithm works as follows:

Each point in the dataset is assigned to the closed cluster, based on the Euclidean distance between each point and each cluster center. Each cluster center is recomputed as the average of the points in that cluster.

The above steps are repeated until the clusters converge.

It is often a good idea to experiment with different values of k to identify the value that best suits your data. You also may wish to explore the use of other data mining algorithms in your quest for machine-learned knowledge. For the present study, K=12 was found to be optimum to find the people below poverty line. The results are given below for the year 2006-2007 and has been compared with the published results of 2003-2004

### Comparison of the results of 2006-07 with 2003-2004

In the year 2003-04, in the state of Andhra Pradesh, 11.1% were below poverty line where in 2006-07, 13.62% belong to the poorer section and their per capita consumer expenditure is RS3788. For the state of Arunachal Pradesh in the year 2003-04, 13.4% were below poverty line, however it is observed that in the year 2006-07, there had been a decrease in the % of poor people's it only 6.24% and their per capita consumer expenditure is RS3620.

For the state of Assam, percentage of poor people gone up 2003-04, only 15% were below poverty line. Whereas in 2006-07 23.7% were poor and their per capita income is RS3347.

For the state of Bihar it is interesting to see in the year 2003-04, 32.5% were below poverty line, however in 2006-07 only 15.1% are poor with the per capita income of RS2633.

Decrease in poverty is observed in the following states in the year 2006-07 in comparison to 2003-04.

### **Extraction of Data**

The data was extracted from the compressed format to a CSV format. Only the relevant fields were extracted. K means clustering algorithm was employed

Description of poverty in States

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- Note :- (1) If no descriptions is available of any religion in any state, it means no information provided in dataset about that religion.  
 (2) If no description is available of any religion in any state category, it means no Person from that religion is present
